HOMEOWNERSHIP

Habitat LA recognizes that our veteran population is rapidly growing, with thousands struggling to meet every day needs, including securing decent and affordable housing.

Habitat LA believes in the strength, security and sustainability that homeownership can provide and we encourage all veterans to apply.

Interested applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements to be considered as a prospective homeowner:

- Meet income qualifications (see website for income guidelines)
- Have good credit (*no judgments, collections or recent bankruptcies*)
- Be a first-time homebuyer
- Contribute 200-500 *sweat equity* hours into the construction of their home and the homes of others

HOME REPAIRS

Habitat LA provides repairs and non-cosmetic improvements to qualified veteran and military households to help alleviate health and safety issues in and around their home. Repairs are offered with two affordable repayment options: A one-time payment or a zero-interest, deferred forgivable loan.
